Dear Parents,

Below are important items as we work toward a successful Sunday School Year for our precious children!

On Time Arrivals:

We request that children always sign in, wear name tag and be in the classroom on time so as not interrupt a lesson that has begun. It may mean arriving by 10:45 AM. The parent who is the volunteer assistant will need to arrive by 10:30 AM.

Parental Assistance:

Unity strongly requests parental support of our program by assisting a teacher in the classroom several times a year. You can sign up for your dates to be in the classroom of your child or another age group. We would expect that by having parents volunteer 3 to 4 times during the school year You will be giving the children and teachers the support that they need. This is not a baby sitting service during service, but rather an opportunity for children to learn the Unity way of life.

Snacks:

No snacks are to be brought to the classroom. All snacks must be left with the hospitality team in the gathering area.

Training and Special Programs:

- We request that parents attend training once or twice a year. Our first training is a special 5 week training in October and November and there is a current flyer available.
- Rev. Diane Venzera from the Great Lakes Region will bring a training to our church for parents and teachers the 1st Saturday after Easter each year from 9AM-4 PM April 18, 2009
- The children will have a Christmas program on Friday, December 12 at 7:00 PM. We request that you attend with your child and bring other family members.
- Children's recognition and award day is Sunday, May 17, 2009 at the 11:00 AM service.
